The Director of Development will work with the Board of Directors, Development Committee, and Executive Director to identify, cultivate, solicit, and steward major and annual fund contributions from individuals, corporations, foundations, and organizations.

The Development Director will take the lead to ensure the successful diversification of the organization's funding through personal solicitations, direct mail, grant proposals, and special events. This position affords the right candidate the unique opportunity to take a leadership role in all aspects of the organization's philanthropic efforts.

Impact on Education's leadership team has ambitious goals for the Foundation, planning to double revenue within the next three to five years, in addition to growing its already healthy endowment and reserves. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to direct that transformation and will work collaboratively with the Executive Director and Board of Directors, as well as the Community Engagement Manager, contract grant writer, and administrative staff to provide outstanding opportunities for donors to be a part of the work we do.
