- 2. Applicant must attend a university or college in the state of Colorado for the upcoming academic year.
- 3. Current college student applicants must have a 2.5 grade point average.
- **4.** Applicant should be enrolled for a minimum of 9 credit hours each semester.

# C. Application Requirements:

- 1. Completed Student Information Form.
- 2. Completed response to essay questions (must be typed).
- 3. Current copy of transcript with GPA
- **4.** Two letters of recommendation (either from a counselor, teacher/advisor and a community representative).
- **5.** Once you have registered for classes, please send Impact on Education proof of your class registration (enrollment), including your Student I.D. and school address. (Can be submitted separately from application). Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the college or university.

# D. Additional Requirements/Requests

- 1. All scholarship recipients are expected to attend the Scholarship awards ceremony. Any change to this requirement requires notification and approval of the Latina League.
