Belief in innovation has always driven our work here at Impact on Education, but never more so than it did in 2012-13. In recognizing the fast-changing landscape of technology in our world, we found that infrastructure in classrooms in our district was stuck in the past while the students inside those rooms

zoomed into the future with connectivity to all forms

of technology. In order to take advantage of both students' affinity towards digital devices and the potential learning techniques those devices can provide, Impact furthered our involvement in a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) program called STREAM.

Our mission is to evolve and meet the ever-changing needs of the BVSD students, teachers, and schools. When teachers and administrators came to us and told us there was need for an innovative STEM program, we addressed that need by a piloting this new STREAM initiative.

By combining science and reading instruction on an iPad, our 21st century students were able to learn skills of collaboration and critical thinking, while also increasing achievement and participation levels. We also invested in developing resources which empower teachers to maximize their use of the technological devices provided.

Thanks to your ongoing support, we continue to serve our BVSD schools and students by emphasizing the importance of innovative learning techniques and classroom environments and advocating for the increase of opportunities made available to all students and educators in the BVSD.

Our Programs

Classroom Innovation Grants

The CIG program is designed to focus on instructional & learning innovation. It is a competitive grant program designed to provide funds for the most innovative, educational and developmental activities created by BVSD teachers. We awarded 59 grants worth over \$50,000, benefitting 8,266 students.

Opportunity Fund

Created to decrease the economic barriers that prevent students from participation, the Opportunity Fund benefitted 6,256 students via improved motivation, engagement and success through increased access to academic and extracurricular activities.

Take My Teacher Home (TMTH)

This program was designed to bring struggling kindergarten readers to at-grade level reading by first grade. TMTH successfully worked with 280 students to increase reading competency through the use of technology. STREAM built upon the four year 'Take My Teacher Home' program.



Math) K-8 Initiative

The STREAM Program has these goals:

- Increase student achievement in science, reading and writing through the use of science literacy integration and student-centered technology
- In particular, to reach students learning English as an additional language, students on IEPs, and students receiving meal assistance)
- Increase students' 21st century skills (collaboration, self-direction, invention, critical thinking)
- Increase student engagement in learning

Successes

STREAM deployed 100 iPads with apps to support instruction into three schools, giving 515 students access to iPads. 28 teachers were trained and coached on the use of iPads to support instruction. Additionally, a website with comprehensive training support and resources was developed. The STREAM initiative was presented at the 2012 TIE (Technology in Education) Conference.

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


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2012-2013 Financials
